<b>All projects must include:</b>	A cover page created by you in Illustrator or Photoshop, and a sources page at the end of your pdf. DO NOT COUNT these pages in the total pages required above.  Sources page must use correct MLA formatting.  Your grade will be reduced by 10% if these pages are not done adequately.	You must have the following types of pages in your pdf file: 1) one web page you have converted to a pdf; 2) one graphic NOT created by you converted to a pdf page; 3) one file created in a word processing program that you have converted to a pdf page; and 4) one page that you have scanned into your pdf project.	The media files must be relevant to your topic, and must help provide insight into your topic.	The websites must be relevant to your topic and must help provide insight into your topic.	You must use buttons to give your pdf some interactive features.	The articles should consist of information that is most relevant/important to your topic.	You must have your pages arranged logically, and set up a logical bookmarks structure.	You must have footers on all pages except the cover page. The footer must contain at least the page number, and can include other logical information if you wish.	Pages should be edited to remove unnecessary information (such as ads and hyperlinks on a web page.) You are also free to relocate page elements to help clean up your pages.
